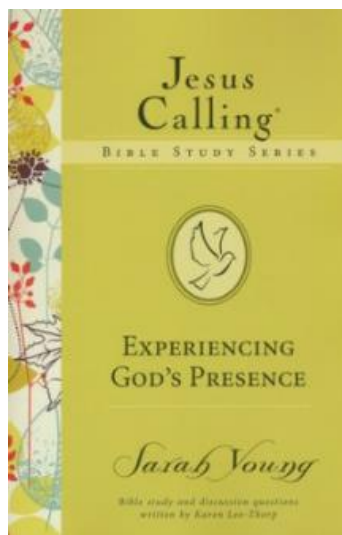
Stewardship 2017

Bible Study on Thursdays

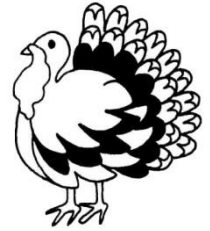
